Chairman's Report

Chairman Hansen stated that we now have a superintendent evaluation process set up in our school system. We can now move forward and build on it from year to year. The Superintendent Performance Evaluation Instrument was a very important process that our system needed.

As, we are approaching the end of the school year we have lots of activities happening – award programs, baccalaureate services and graduation! The baccalaureate service was held at Collierville Methodist Church. It was very well attended by parents and students. This is a non-compulsory event, but there were so many students that attended that additional seats had to be found. This was a wonderful ending to the school year! We are very fortunate to have the leadership in the Senior Class at Collierville High School. Mr. Hansen is very proud of the students, teachers and administrators. Even though there is an overcrowded situation at the high school, they do a phenomenal job to make the school year flow with minimal disruption to the children.

Another issue we faced this past year, was the condition of the track. The process of getting the track fixed was a testament to local control that we chose when we created Collierville Schools. It was a grassroots situation where students, coaches and parents came to us individually and said they needed the track repaired. Even though, we did not have the money in the budget, we went to the Board and Mayor of Alderman and the Town Administrator and told them we had a problem that needed to be fixed. We owe the Town a hugh thanks as they appropriated the funds for this improvement to occur. The track has been repaved, resurfaced and is in the process of being striped. Additionally, Mr. Vaughan also went to St. George's School and in a spirit of cooperation they agreed to allow us to use their track for dragon relays at their facilities. All in all it was done locally, quickly and satisfactorily. The board was very pleased with the work of the Superintendent and Mr. Simpson in getting this project on its way to completion. We were very responsive to the children and had this problem fixed and it shows where our local control really works.

Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Aitken first of all thanked Collierville Middle School for hosting our meeting tonight. Also, thanks to our Curriculum and Human Resource Departments for their work in preparation for the retiree reception.
