Dear Mr. Simpson:

We have completed our review of the two bids received on April 16, 2014 for the referenced project. We found both bids comply with the requirements indicated in the project manual. A tabulation of the bids received is attached for your reference.

Based on our review of the submitted bids, the low Bidder, Jolly Roofing and Contracting Company, Inc., is a qualified, licensed roofing contractor in the State of Tennessee, and has submitted a complete and responsible bid package for this project. We have compared the bid amount with our estimate and found the bid responsible and reasonable. The grand total amount of the low bid is **\$846,058.00** which includes the base bid plus all alternates. This grand total also includes construction allowance and contingency in the amount of \$73,250 that could be used for unforeseen conditions.

For reference checks, I have spoken to Mr. Brian Wilcox, Director of Facility Management of the University of Memphis as well as several local general contractors. No one expressed any concerns regarding quality of their staff and work.

We believed that Jolly Roofing is qualified to perform the work in a satisfactory manner to Collierville Schools. It is our recommendation that the referenced contract be awarded to Jolly Roofing and Contracting Company, Inc.

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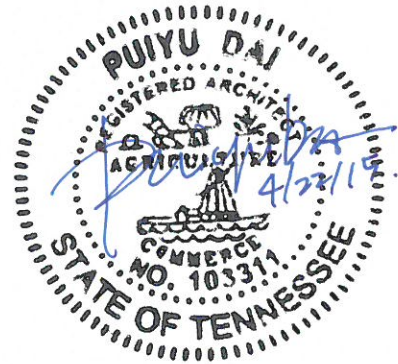

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

1. Meeting was moderated by Tony Dai, BWSC (Tony).
2. Introductions.
3. Tony announced that a sign-in sheet was being passed around, that this pre-bid meeting is mandatory, and that only those attending this meeting can submit a bid. The sign-in sheet will be referenced at the bid opening and a Contractor's bid will not be opened if his name does not appear on the list. The sign-in sheet will also be the distribution list for the meeting minutes and any addenda issued.
4. The project scope of work was reviewed. In general the scope of work includes the following:
 - Removal of EPDM ballasted Roof
 - repair
 - new cover board
 - New TPO roofing
 - All necessary accessory
5. Contract Time is set at 60 calendar days. Once the Notice to Proceed has been issued, every day on the calendar counts against contract time.
6. Liquidated Damages are set at \$200 per calendar day beyond the established contract time.

7. Mr. Mike Simpson explains how this particular roofing project is funded. Davis Bacon wage rates do not apply. There is also no Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal.
8. Tony indicated that Contractors will be required to have a site foreman on site at all times that work is being performed under his contract, including work by his subcontractors.
9. "Porta-johns" will be required for contractor's employees.
10. The successful bidder will be required to add the Collierville as an additionally insured on their insurance policy.
11. Contractors were advised that although they are not performing work during school hours, safety is still top concern.
12. The school building will remain open and possibly utilized by maintenance staff. Work must be carried out in a manner to allow access for tenants.
13. Addendum verification sheets from all addenda issued must be signed by the Contractor and returned (fax or email) to BWSC for verification of receipt. Signed addenda must be attached to the front page of the proposal.
14. Contractors were referred to the general conditions of the project manual for bidding and contract requirements, and for procedures by which contracts will be awarded and executed.
15. Contractors were advised that the provided form must be completed. Failure to do so could disqualify a bid.
16. Bidding forms provided within the Project Manual must be completed, all loose sheets should be attached to the Project Manual, and the entire Project Manual inserted in an envelope and sealed with the appropriate information provided on the outside of the sealed envelope. State bid law applies.

This Addendum shall apply to the Drawings and Specifications for the above referenced project and shall be bound into and made a part of the Construction Documents issued by Barge Waggoner Sumner and Cannon Inc, titled as indicated above. Prospective bidders are hereby informed that the plans, specifications and contract documents are revised as follows:

Clarifications:

1. Reference Project Specification Section 00700 GENERAL CONDITIONS, Paragraph 12, **No** exception will be provided for the TN State Law requirement. The successful bidder is required to fully comply with the requirements as stated.
2. All existing EPS cricket along the parapet wall within the project limit to be removed and replaced by tapered polyisocyanurate cricket to allow proper installation of TPO system as well as prevent ponding between scupper openings. For reference use, attached is an existing tapered EPS cricket layout drawing of the 1995 high school addition. No responsibility for accuracy or completeness is assumed by the Collierville Schools or A/E. Prospective bidders shall examine the project site and the information available to draw their own conclusions.
3. Slope of cricket along the parapet wall can be reduced from its current slope to allow for secured attachment of available roofing screws.
4. It is confirmed that at the cementitious deck area above gymnasium, underneath the ballasted EPDM roofing is a layer of 1/2" EPS board on top of the polyisocyanurate insulation attached to the cementitious deck. The EPS board shall be removed and replaced by polyisocyanurate board for proper roofing system installation. Abutting the cementitious deck area is the typical roof installation with ballasted EPDM directly on polyisocyanurate insulation board placed on rated gypsum board above steel decking.
5. Contractor shall be responsible for providing all necessary treated wood blocking at the top of all parapet wall for proper roofing system and edge metal installation

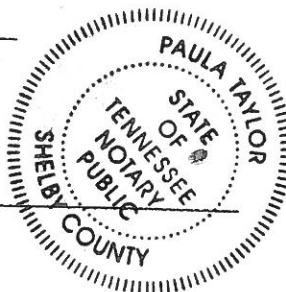




